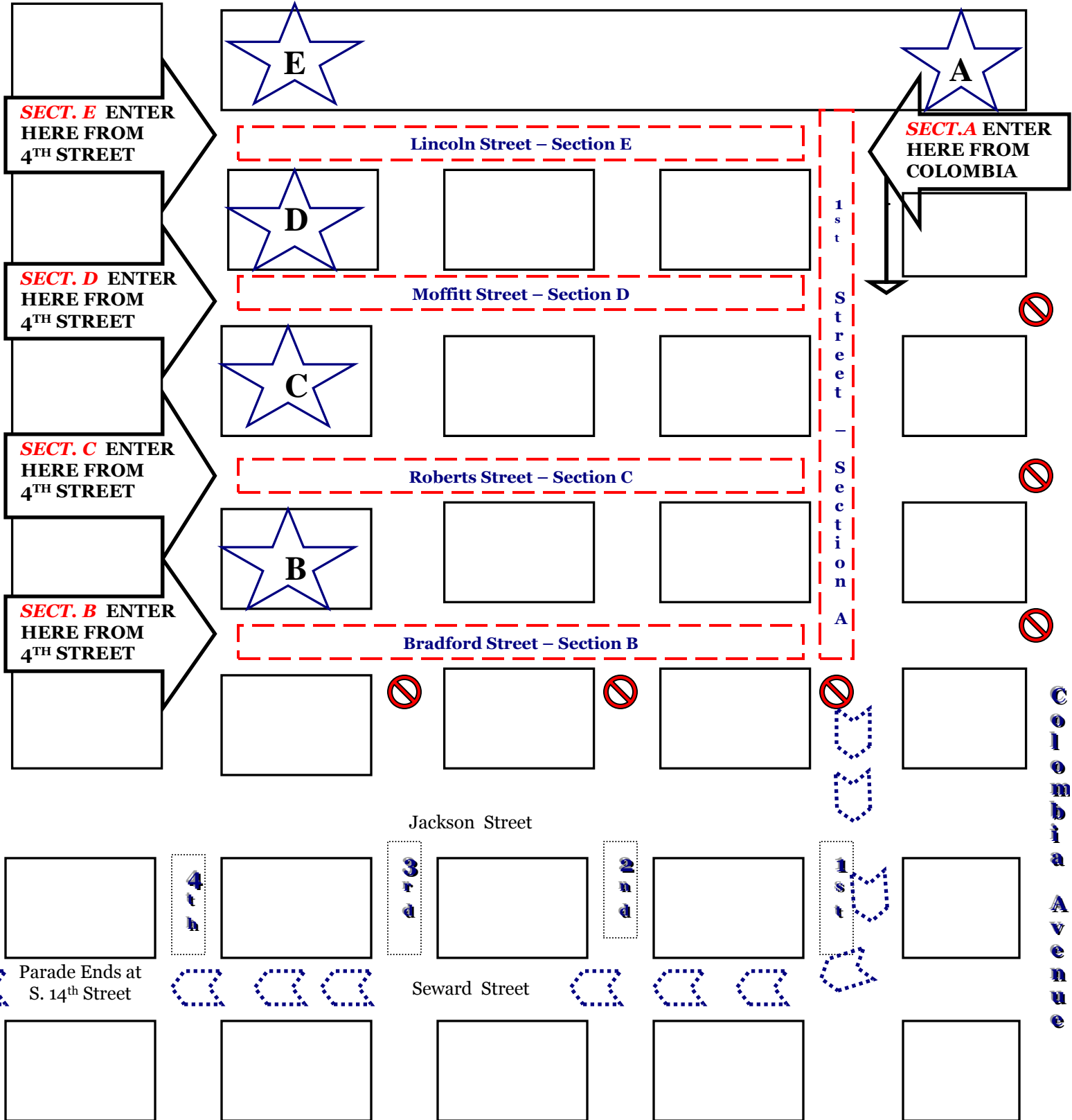

Parade Route



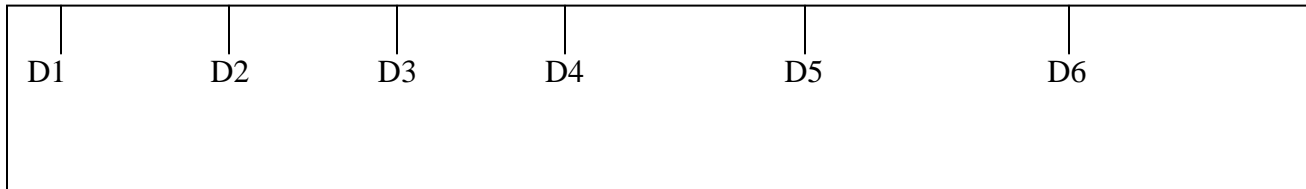

# Parade Line Up Instructions

1. Follow Map Directions to your designated section. If you follow these directions you will already be facing the correct direction for line up. Please follow these directions to decrease traffic jams, increase safety for parade participants, and create greater movement in the sections. Thank You.

2. Line up starts at 2pm you are to be in your spot and ready no later than 3:15 PM. You must have already made arrangements ahead of time if this creates a conflict. Thank You.

3. The spots for each entry will be marked on the road with chalk your number will be at front of your entry spot. It will look something like this but not exactly like this:



4. Section entry points will be marked with signs.

5. Check In will be at the entry point to your assigned section. Please be sure to stop and let the parade officials know that you have arrived so that we know you are here and can give you your participation ribbon. Check In is to be NO Later than 3:10 unless you have prearranged with the parade chair.

6. *If* you have signs to be put on they will be found at the Section Checkpoint with a Parade Official.

7. Keep out of the roads. It is imperative that the middle of the road remain clear of unnecessary traffic and people standing around. This helps to ensure that mobility for emergency vehicles and other such events.

8. Any misconduct during line up shall result in your entry not participating in the parade. There will be no fighting amongst entries over any subject matter. You will treat all volunteers with respect and conduct yourselves in an orderly fashion. Any concerns that you have will be directed toward the Parade Chair and not amongst yourselves. In the event that you have a concern you may contact the parade chair on her cell phone (402-641-8912) and she will be glad to hear your concerns and find a comprimable solution. If there is ***any*** argument with the Parade Chair and/or any Parade Official's decision you will **NOT** participate in the parade. Assignments and Measurements are made based upon information given on the forms that you have filled out. That is another reason why it's important to be as accurate and informative as possible.
